Determine the name of each grandson, the topic of their pillowcase, the color of the trim added to the edge of the pillowcase, and the month of each grandson's birthday.

1. Frank didn't get a yellow trim on his pillowcase. Elliot's birthday was in January but he didn't get a pillowcase with a brown trim. Allan didn't get a pillowcase with cowboys.
2. The five grandsons were Joe, the boy got the dinosaurs pillowcase, the boy whose birthday was in March, the boy who got the pillowcase with the brown trim, and Frank.
3. Peter's birthday was one month before the boy who had cowboys on his pillowcase but it was also after the boy who got a red trim.
4. Joe got a green trim on his pillowcase but no trucks. Frank's birthday was not in May.
5. The boy whose birthday was in March got a hockey pillowcase but it wasn't Allan. Joe's birthday was in September.
6. The boy whose birthday was in April got a pillowcase with a blue trim but no dogs.
