3. The one who got the high heels had a mother named Lydia.
4. Rob's daughter wasn't Arlene. The daughter whose last name was Yang picked up a pair of pumps.
5. Nancy, whose last name wasn't Nacomb, picked up her shoes the day before the girl who got her sandals and the day after Lydia's daughter.
6. Kelly was Larry's daughter but she didn't pick up her shoes on Monday. The girl who picked up her boots came in on Thursday.
