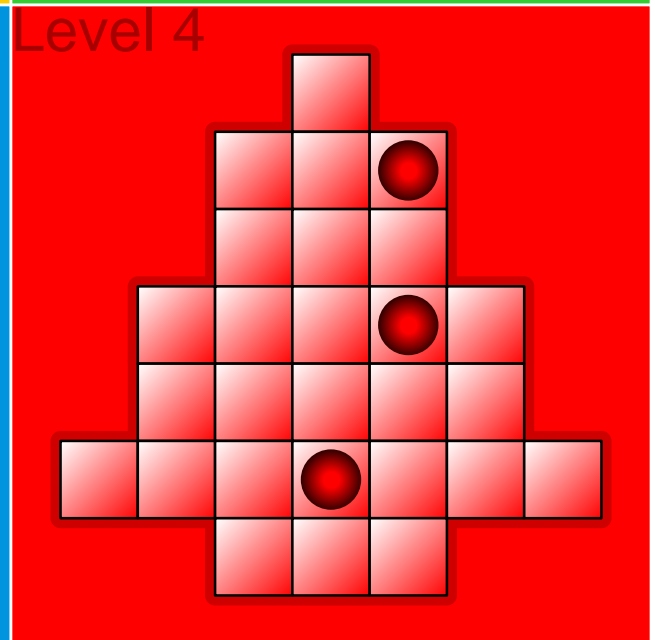
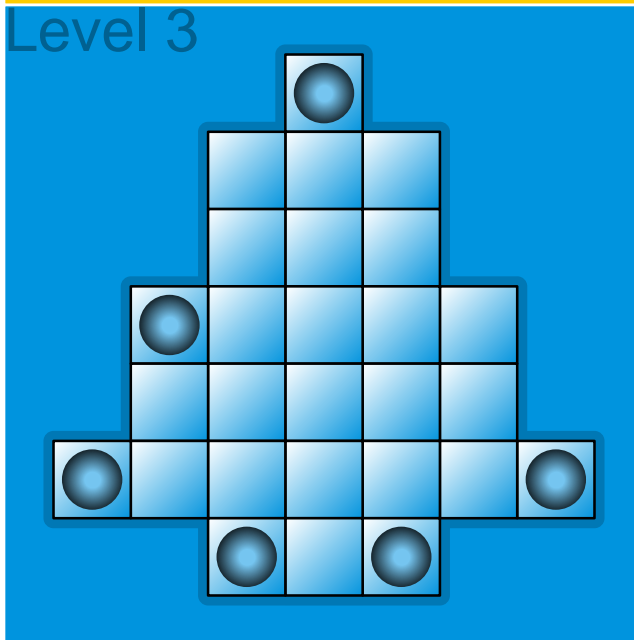
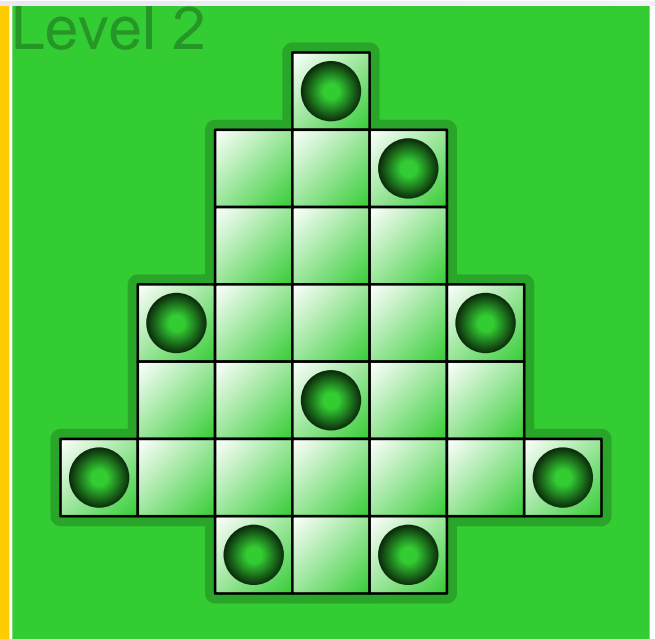
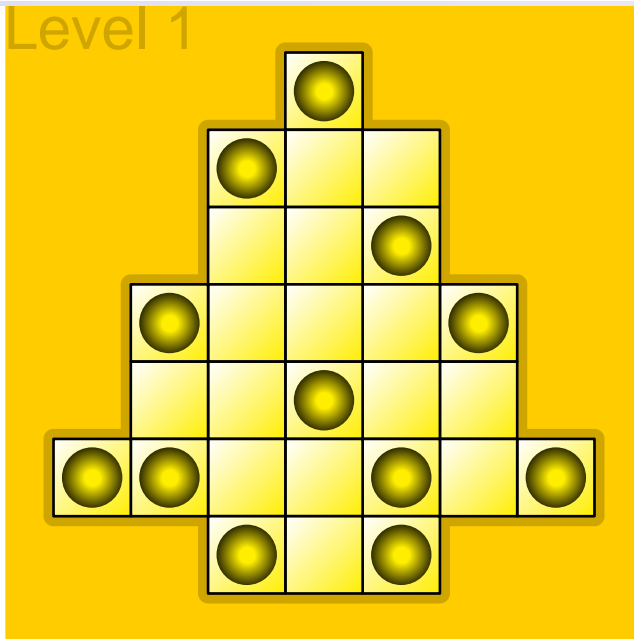


Holiday Dissections

The object is to group all the empty cells on each tree into three congruent parts – a different kind of part per each Christmas tree. The parts can be symmetrical.

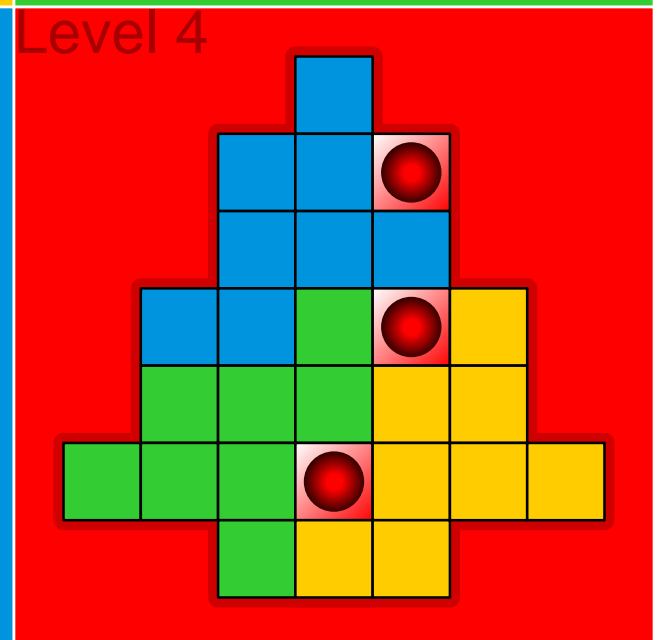
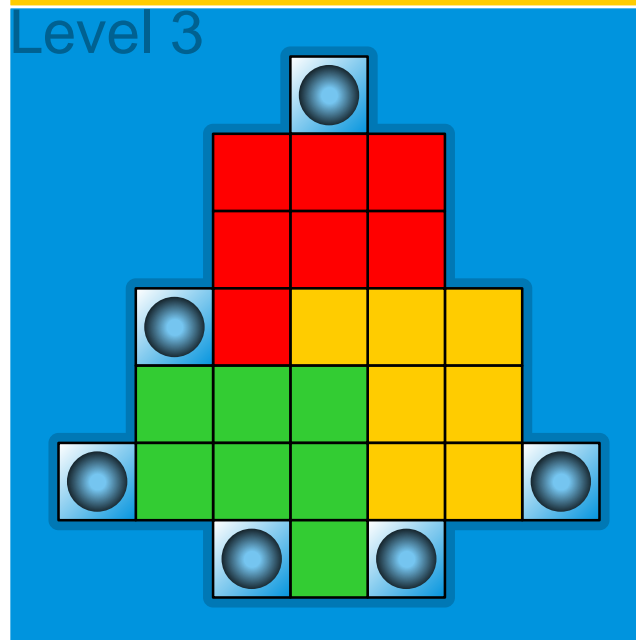
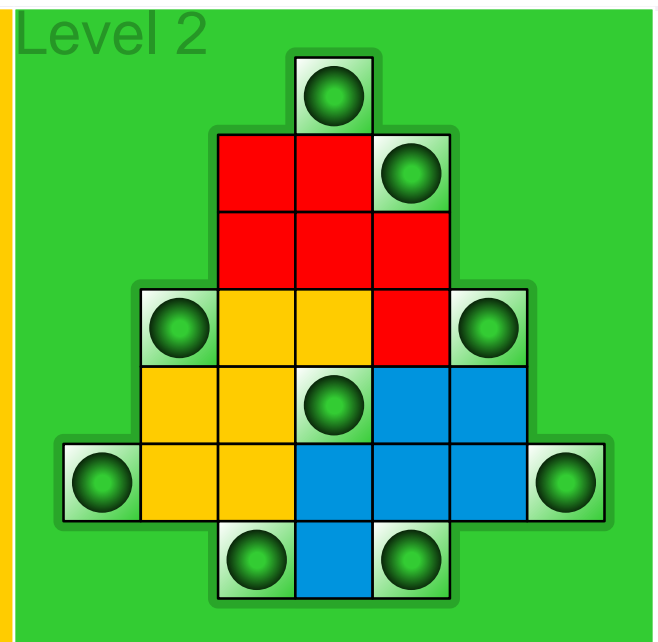
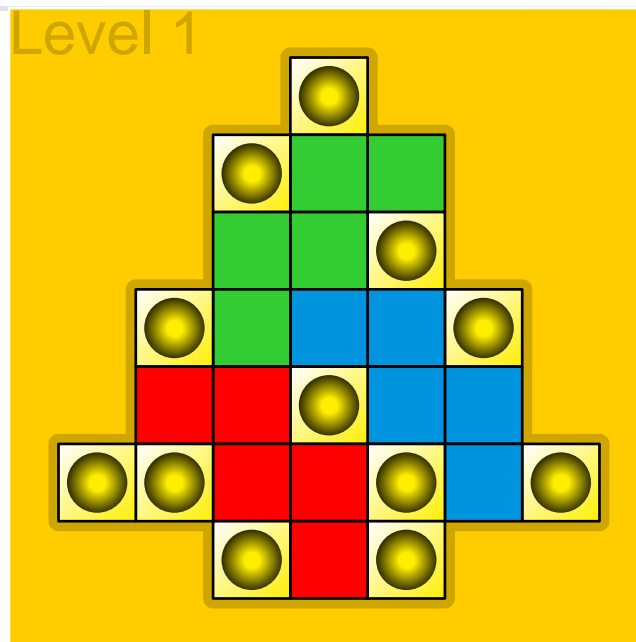
