



**Answer:** From left to right we have... Rose, Daisy and Iris.

**Here's how:** The woman wearing the rose corsage is not Rose; nor is she Iris, for Iris responded to her observation. Therefore, she must be Daisy. This means Iris must be wearing the daisy corsage, leaving Rose wearing the iris.
