

## Fishing Trip

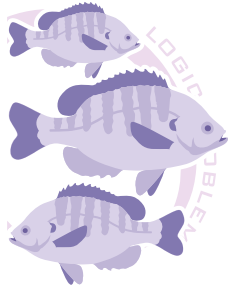
