3. Martin, whose last name wasn't Fisher, won \$8,000 on the show he attended, just \$4,000 less than what Mr. Grant won.
4. Mr. Dover won the most but he didn't play on Jeopardy. Mr. Court didn't appear on Wheel of Fortune.
5. The man who played on Jeopardy won \$2,000 more than the one who played on Hollywood Squares.
6. The man who appeared on Wheel of Fortune won \$2,000 less than Greg won.
